This Month's Presenter

Past President John Menke

John took his bachelor's degree in physics at Rensselaer and did graduate work at the University of Maryland, but says his true love was "doing" ever so much more than schooling.

John worked at the Bureau of Standards in nuclear research, Mitre Corporation on destruction of nerve gas in the Pacific, and Menke Scientific crafting astronomy observatories sold worldwide.

"Bitten by by the public interest bug," John was elected and served on the Montgomery County Council for four years and then as the county's Director of Environmental Protection.

In 1990, this smart guy got really smart and married Meg. They are active in the Frederick Unitarian Church and Frederick Torch where John has spoken on instruments, waves, and spectroscopy. John is also a well qualified member of Frederick's old guys' Coffee Club.

Most Recent Presentation

Captain Dana French on "Vietnam Boat People Rescue"

For more than two decades after the end of the Vietnam War, hundreds of thousands Vietnamese escaped their country as refugees from the new communist government. Many, the Boat People, escaped by sea where many died. The luckiest were rescued, made it to another another country and survived.



Captain French told us the story of one such boat of 300 people who in December of 1980 were rescued from death by the crew of USS Robison which he commanded. This fascinating talk told of the refugees, Captain French's ship and crew, immigration, and his reuniting 30 years later with some of those he had rescued to share their stories.
